# **Eric B. & Robert Hare Collection**

## **(Collection 40)**

### **Scope and Content**

Eric B. Hare (1894-1982) was a prolific writer of articles and author of six books. He served as a missionary in Burma (1915-1934), Sabbath School director in Southeastern California Conference, youth director in the Pacific Union, and associate Sabbath School director for the General Conference. He was best known as a teller of children's stories.

Robert Hare (1858-1953) was one of the first converts to Seventh-day Adventism in New Zealand through the preaching of S. N. Haskell. He served the Adventist Church in Australia as Bible teacher, editor, pastor, and poet. He is the father of Eric.

This collection contains mainly books and book manuscripts by Eric B. Hare and his father, Robert Hare, plus a few unpublished manuscripts and photographs taken by Eric B. Hare.
