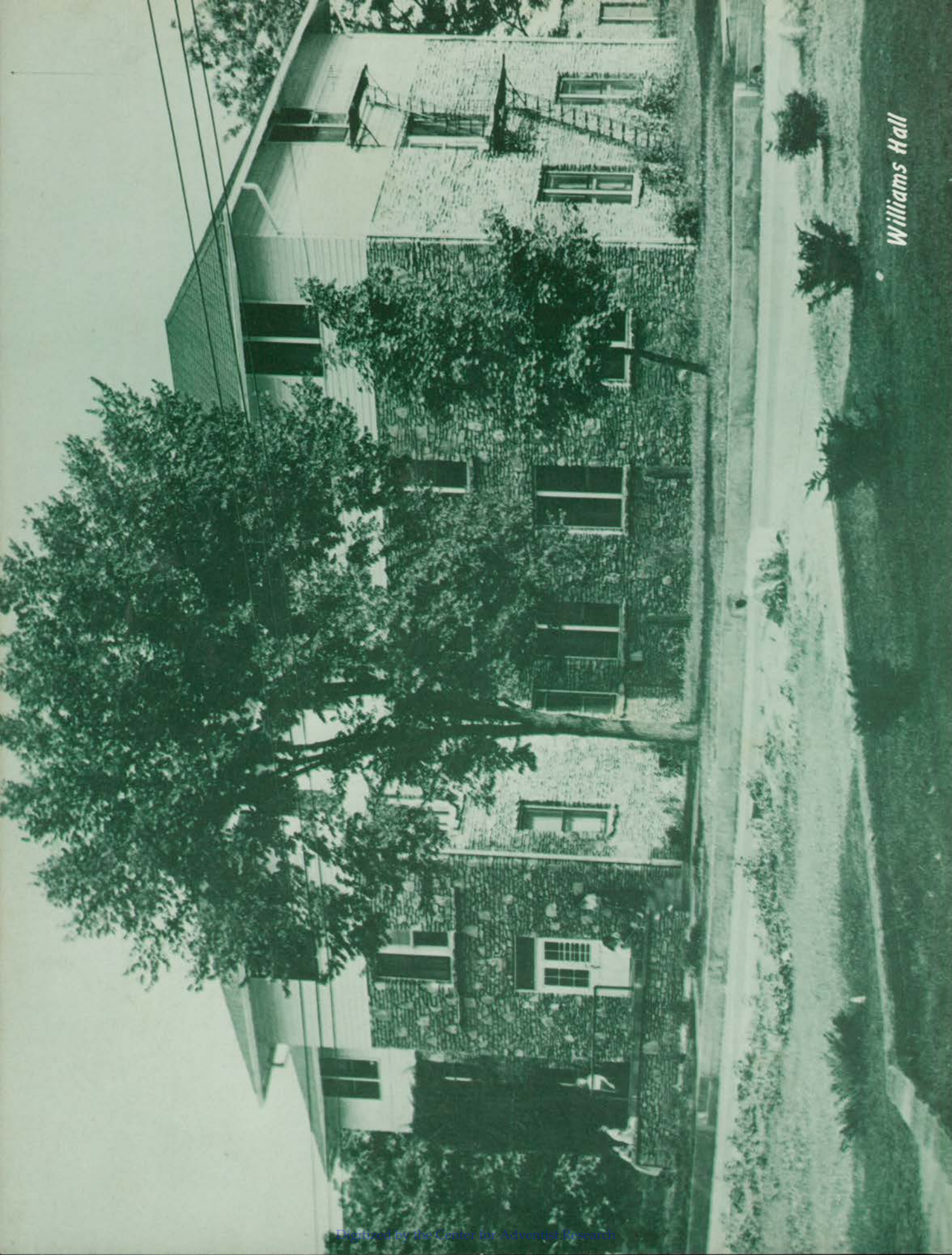

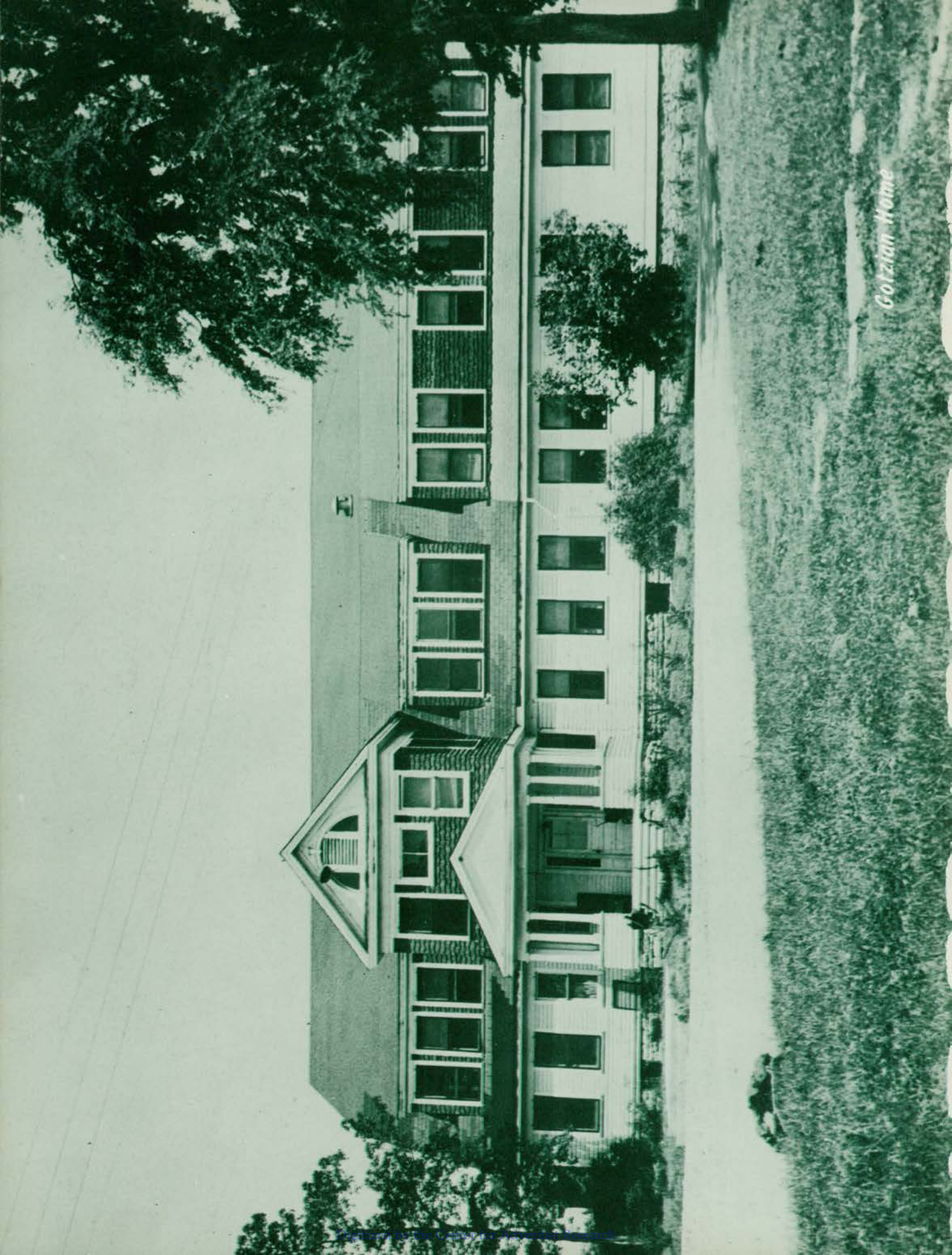

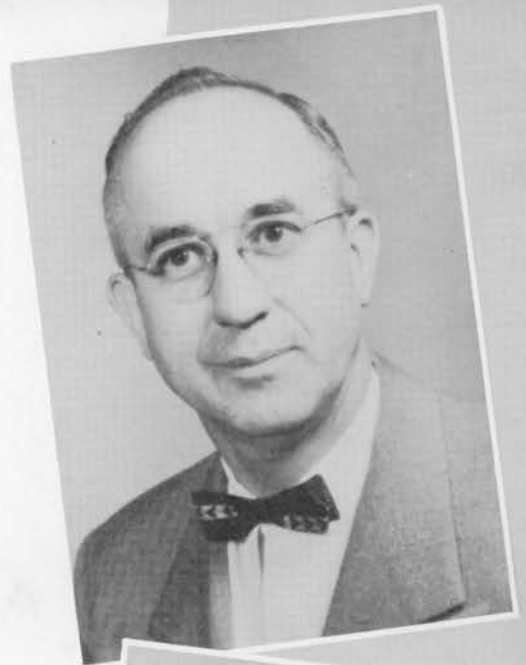


## *Dean's Message*
