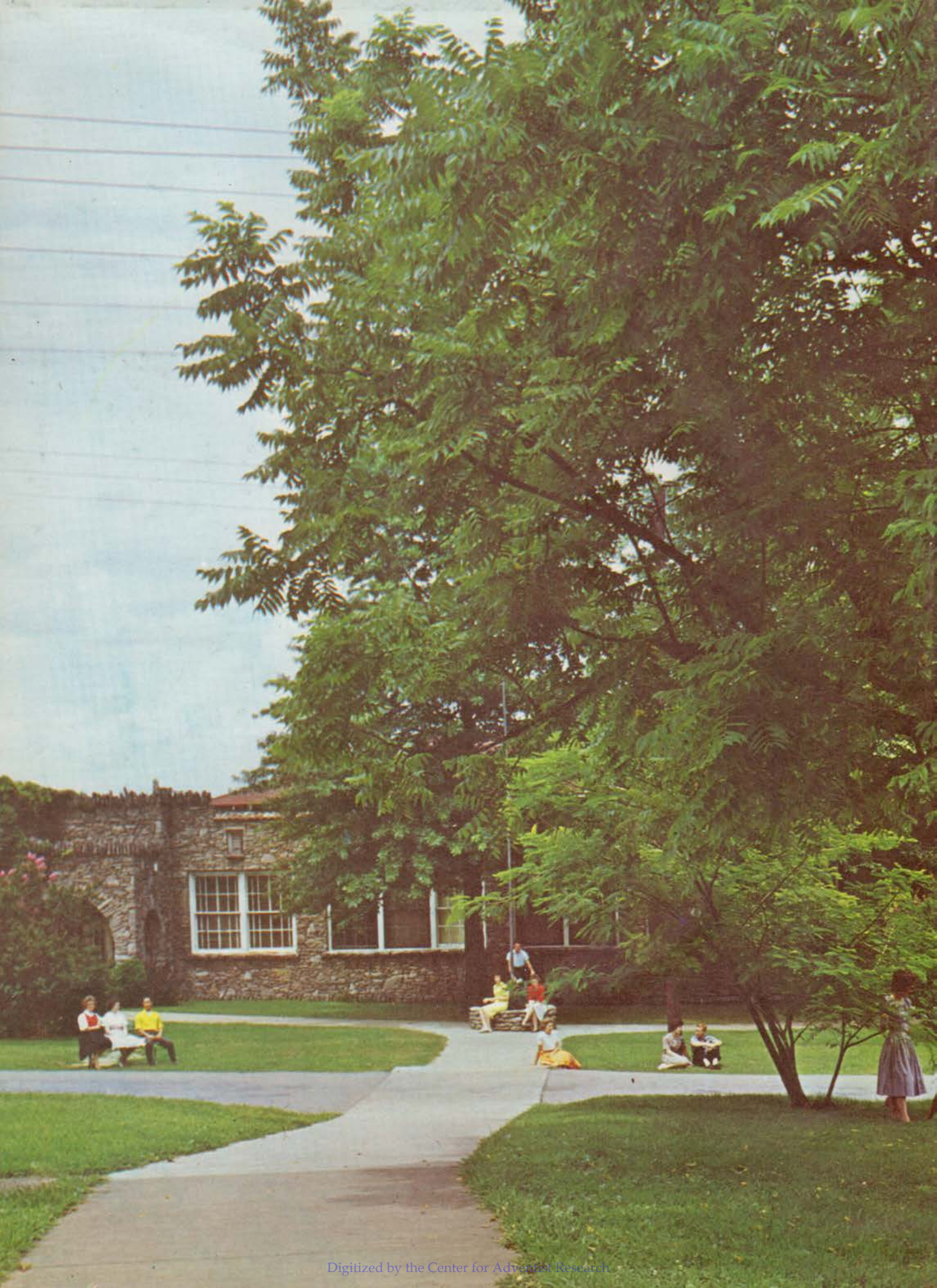

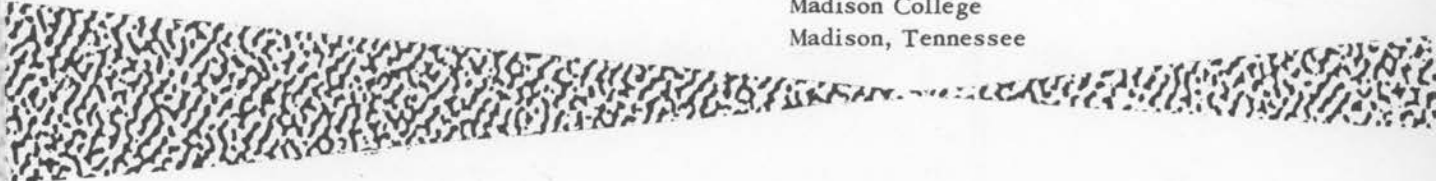

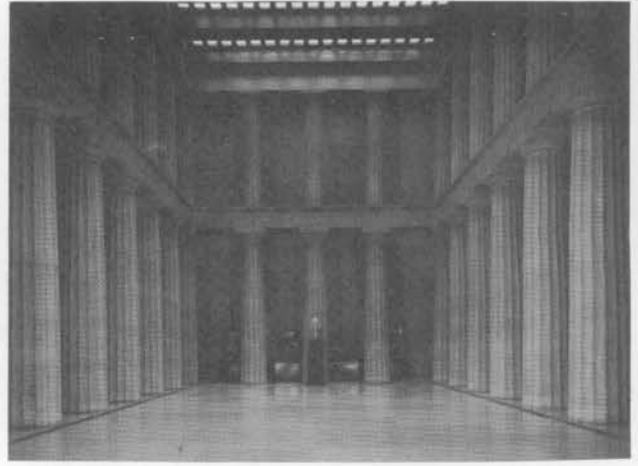
## Foreword

# *The Hermitage*



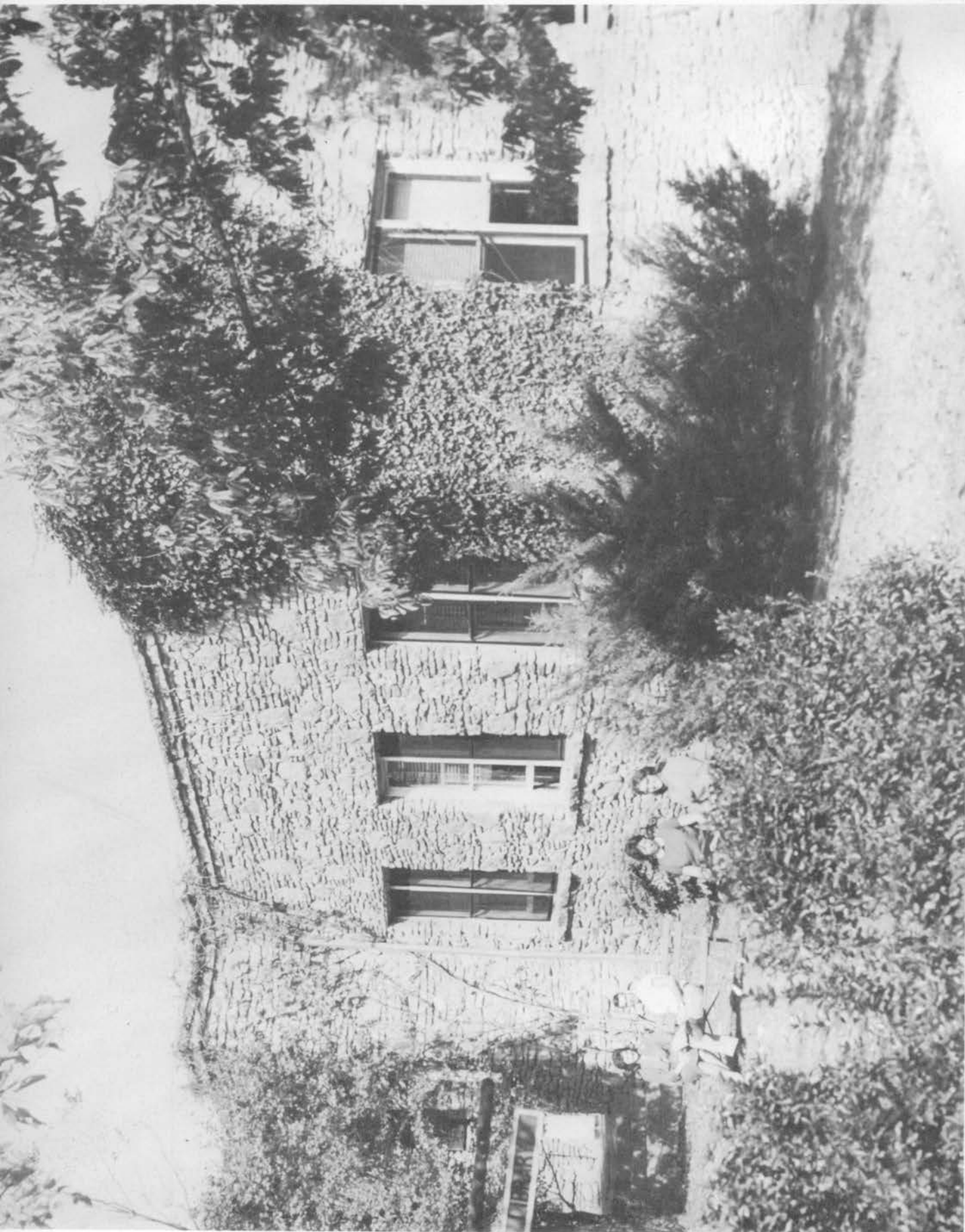

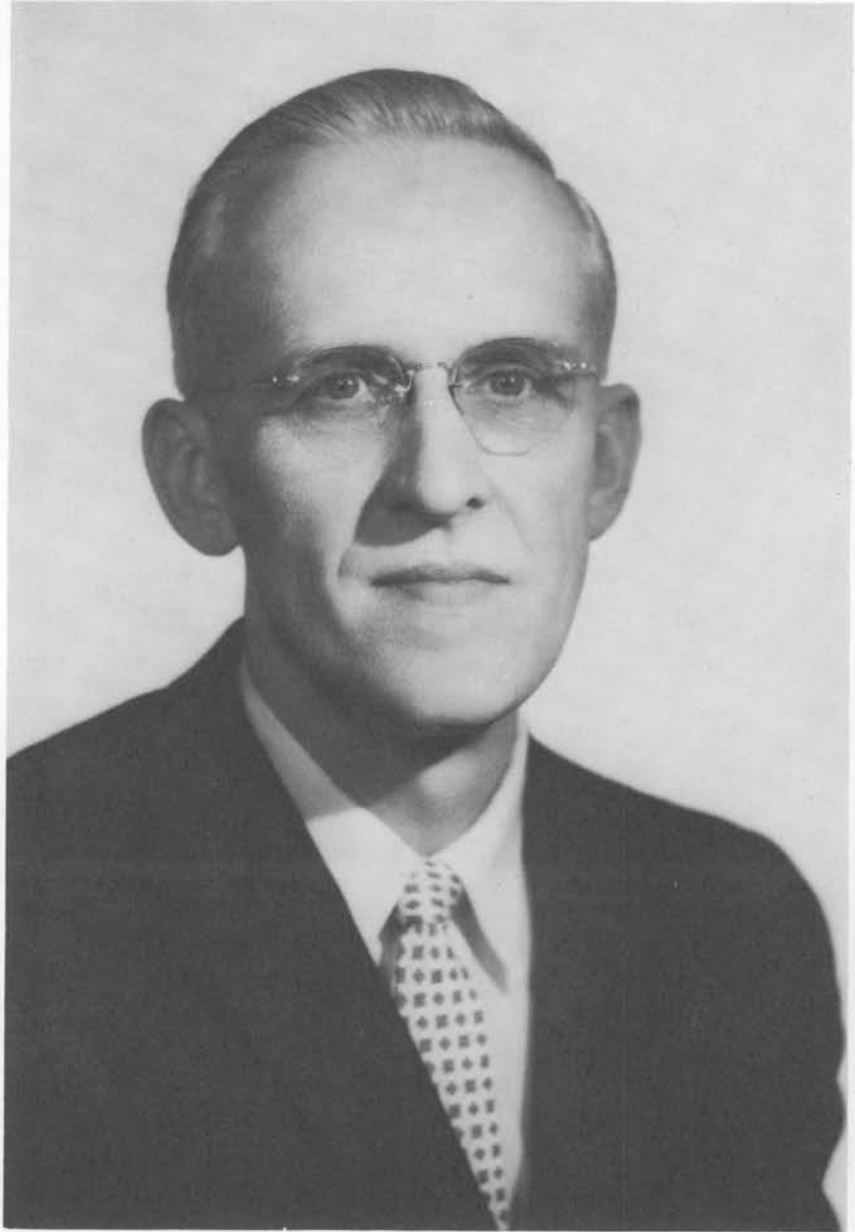






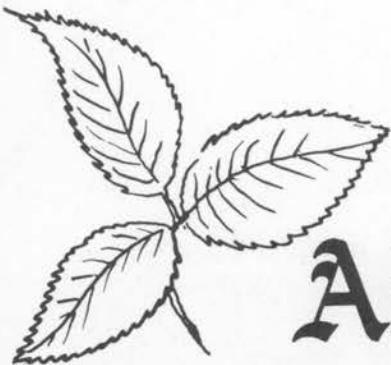

# Administration





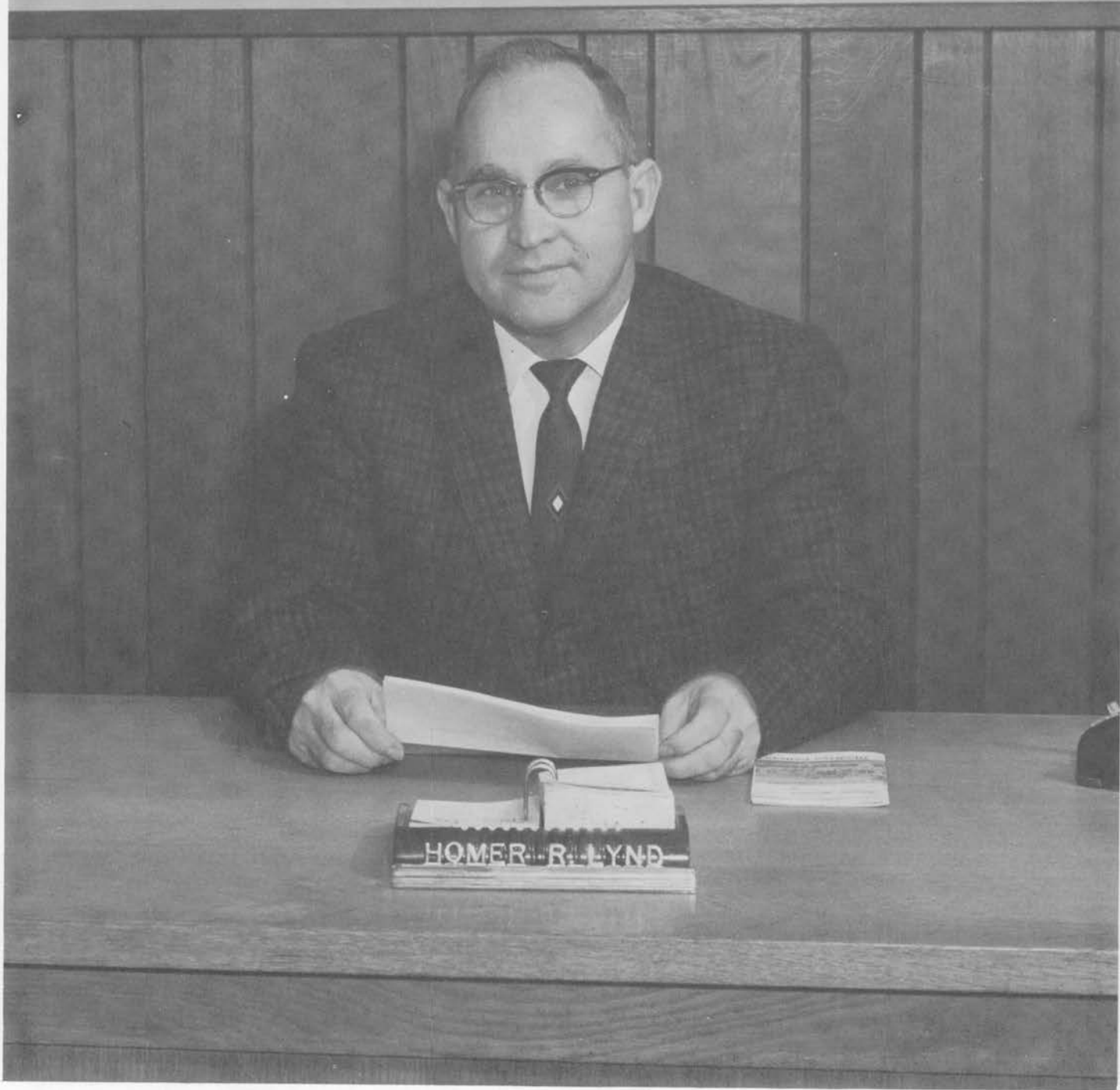
