Scope and Content

Winton Henry Beaven,(1915–2003) was an Adventist educator, college administrator, lecturer, and broadcaster. He was president of the International Committee for the Prevention of Alcoholism. He spoke and taught in many countries, including Canada, Australia, Poland, and Yugoslavia.

Winton was born January 26, 1915, in Binghamton, New York, to William H. Beaven (1885-1979) and Eva Lucinda Longway (1891-1974). By 1920, the family was living in Oneida, New York, where both parents were public school teachers. The Beavens had two sons, Winton and Bruce Lee (1925-1966).

Beaven graduated in 1937 with a Bachelor of Arts degree in history from Atlantic Union College in South Lancaster, Massachusetts. He later earned a Master's degree from Clark University in Worcester, Massachusetts, and a Ph.D. from the University of Michigan in 1950.

Beaven's positions as educator included teaching Bible and English at Atlantic Union College, assistant professor of English and speech at Union College, speech professor at the University of Michigan, and as a professor at the Seventh-day Adventist Theological Seminary. He was dean at Potomac University from 1956 to 1959 and served as dean and then president of Columbia Union College from 1959 to 1970 and provost of Kettering College from 1970 to 1983. He was also associate secretary of the American Temperance Society and worked in the summer Institutes of Scientific Study for Prevention of Alcoholism in Loma Linda, California, and Washington, D.C.

In 1965, Beaven, then president of Columbia Union College, and Sligo Church Pastor William Loveless jointly produced a television program that addressed religious and ethical issues. It is reported that they gave over 3,000 Bibles away to listeners in the first year.

Beaven and colleague Anna May Vaughan were honored by the founding of the Kettering College Service Learning Leadership Program (SLLP). This program was designed to help health students expand their care for patients and to assist others for successful lives no matter where the person lived around the world.

Beaven retired in July 1983, but did not stop working at Kettering College. He served as assistant to the president for special projects.

Beaven married Barbara Halifax (1920-2005) in 1938. The marriage produced six children--three boys and three girls--Cherie, Eric, Barbara, Connie, Barry, and Marc. In 1969, he married Lorraine Smith. He and Lorraine had one daughter, Lara.

Winton Beaven died on May 12, 2003 in Dayton, Ohio, and was buried with his parents in the McConnellsville Cemetery in McConnellsville, Oneida County, New York.

In 1952, Beaven wrote in *Ministry* that the postwar religious awakening had increased the number of men seeking to enter the ministry. Most theology seminaries were expanding to hold all the men wanting to become ministers. The preaching of these ministers, he said, had improved greatly. He also encouraged ministers to personalize their sermons, including words like I, we, and you.

Beaven frequently wrote about alcoholism and the challenges it presented the medical community in helping those who were addicted to alcohol. He was also an acknowledged leader in narcotics education, and said that illegal drugs are harmful or they would not be classified as drugs. Beaven took a great interest in drug use in the Seventh-day Adventist church and investigated it through many studies of the problem among church members. The result was to set up a curriculum that would help students from K-12, starting at Andrews University and spreading throughout the United States.

Beaven's publishing work took the form of a book called, *Now You're Living: Basic information for Scientific Education for Prevention of Alcoholism and Drug Addiction*, and another one entitled, *Whither Research?* He collaborated on another book entitled, *Building a Tradition of Caring*. He also wrote articles on speech in the *Quarterly Journal of Speech* and articles in other journals and magazines such as *Listen*. Most of the above is from the Encyclopedia of Seventh-day Adventists, accessed October 16, 2024.

Dr. Beaven was a very influential and well-known leader in Seventh-day Adventist higher education over several decades. His influence was felt all over North America. He spoke at 56 schools for graduation, some more than once; he spoke to every Adventist Academy in North America at least twice, also at 43 conferences in the United States and in over 100 countries.

Beaven was involved in many different causes during his academic career. He chaired many foundations and organizations, was an ordained minister, co-created and hosted an Emmy-nominated talk show, *Concept*. He served many companies as a management consultant. He served as the President of the American Temperance Society and the International Committee for Prevention of Alcoholism, and as a special General Conference presidential appointee for chemical abuse prevention, and consulted with the governments of Poland, Australia, Afghanistan, Canada, Kuwait, Qatar, Saudi Arabia, the Sudan, and Kenya.

This collection includes correspondence letters, publications, awards, videos, lecture materials, and other topical documents covering his broad and diverse career. The collection follows a time line of Dr. Beaven's life from high school to his time in retirement, and later his death.

Arrangement

This collection is arranged according to the way Beaven kept his files. Thus it follows the original arrangement of how it was arranged when given to the Center of Advent Research, with slight modifications here and there for easier use by researchers. Within this collection there are digital files (photographs and Microsoft Word documents) that are connected to some of the categories below. Included with the collection is a binder explaining where each digital file is, and a description of the files. Referring to the digital files will help gain a picture of the collection's contents.

Provenance

The collection was donated to the Center for Adventist Research by Lorraine Beaven in November 2011. Later that same year, Mrs. Beaven donated DVD's containing scanned copies of selected portions of the papers. She donated audio cassette recordings of Winton's sermons and talks in 2016.
