## Elsie (Howe) Brigham Papers (Collection 209)

#### **Biography**

Elsie Howe was born December 25, 1840, in the State of New York. She was the daughter of Franklin and Rhoda Howe. On August 10, 1862, she married Noble S. Brigham. To them was born one daughter, Rhoda (Mrs. H. M. Dunlap), at whose home in Battle Creek, Michigan, Elsie died suddenly on August 6, 1917. She was survived by her husband, daughter, and two adopted children. When nineteen years of age, Elsie became a member of the Seventh-day Adventist church, being baptized by Elder Joseph Bates. To the end of her life she was an earnest, devoted Christian.

#### Scope

The Elsie (Howe) Brigham Papers contain a little family history, but is largely composed of her diaries covering the last 20 years of her life. They reveal her individual spiritual life, among other things.

The diaries are in chronological sequence. The diaries are photocopies on letter-size paper and bound in hard covers. This is how they were received.
