Irwin H. Evans Papers (Collection 065)

Biography

Irwin Henry Evans was born on April 10, 1862, at North Plains, Ionia County, Michigan. He was educated in the local public schools before attending Battle Creek College. He was baptized in 1874 and entered the ministry in 1882, in Michigan. In 1885, Irwin moved to Kentucky and was ordained to the gospel ministry the following year. In July 1887, he married Emma Ferry. Four children were born to them, three of whom survived. Mrs. Evans died early in the year of 1903. In 1904, Evans married Adelaide B. Cooper, who was then editor of *The Youth's Instructor*. They both served in foreign missions, primarily in China and the Far East.

Elder Evans was well known among church members not only as a strong administrator but as a forceful preacher and author. He made large contributions to our literature as the author of *The Preacher and His Preaching*, *Ministry of Angels*, *The Way of Love Divine*, and *This Is the Way*, plus scores of periodical articles. In addition to these, he carried heavy responsibility in connection with the development of the 1941 *Church Hymnal*. His efforts towards this production proved an undue strain on his physical health.

In his later years, he was very interested in the development of the Seventh-day Adventist Theological Seminary and was a member of the board of trustees until failing health led him to withdraw. He always promoted the development of the younger men in this cause and took great pleasure in watching their growth with responsibility.

He died at Takoma Park, Maryland, on November 24, 1945, at the age of eighty-three.

Scope and Content

Evans' collection contains his books, articles, lectures and sermons written while serving the Seventh-day Adventist Church in various capacities until his retirement in 1941. His books, articles and lectures are on Homiletics and ministry, both published and unpublished. The collection also has articles, mission reports, meeting minutes and special addresses that Evans authored while presiding over the Far Eastern Division. The collection also contains articles edited by J. N. Andrews, letters written by Ellen G. White, James White, James Ertzenberger and Mrs. White's important quotations which are listed in the inventory. Evans was well known not only as a leader of the church but also as a public speaker and author.

Arrangement

The materials are kept in chronological sequence in the categories of book manuscripts, articles, lectures, sermons, reports, letters and articles authored by other writers.
