Paul T. Gibbs Papers (Collection 037)

Biography

Paul T. Gibbs (1897-1977) was a professor of English literature. He graduated from Union College in 1919 and got a M.A. from the University of Nebraska in 1926, and a Ph.D. from the University of Washington in 1937.

He taught at Broadview College (1926-1928), Walla Walla College (1928-1937), Washington Missionary College(1937-1946), Pacific Union College (1946), Emmanuel Missionary College and Andrews university (1946-1966), and Newbold Missionary College(1953-54). He retired in 1966 and became professor emeritus of English at Andrews University.

His teaching focused on English literature, but wrestled with how to teach literature from a Christian perspective instead of secular. As a result of his thinking and research, and using Ellen G. White's writings as a basis, he compiled several books on Christian literature.

He contributed to denominational periodicals, mostly to *The Youth's Instructor*, from 1926 onward, and he published several books.

Scope

This collection consists mainly of Gibb's manuscripts and articles including his autobiography and letters.

Arrangement

The materials are rearranged by topical sequence. Within each topic, they are arranged chronologically or alphabetically.

The source of the collection is not clear, though it was likely Paul Gibbs himself or his family. In 1978, Paul's wife sent two manuscripts to add to the collection following his death.
