Donald F. Haynes Collection (Collection 47)

Scope and Content

Donald Frederick Haynes (1907-1975), son of Carlyle B. Haynes, gifted in music, served as pastor-evangelist for the Seventh-Day Adventist Church.

This collection contains many articles and newspaper clippings documenting Haynes' evangelistic series and other events in his life. There are also numerous photographs. The original collection, as received, contained three boxes of music books which were not retained in the collection. There was a combination of sacred and secular music. Haynes and his family were obvious quite active in the music scene, but the music seemed to bear little relevance to this collection.

Arrangement

The scrapbooks are kept as Haynes left them and are arranged chronically based on the information provided inside each of them. The rest of the materials were arranged by the Center for Adventist Research according to topics.

Provenance

Most of this collection was donated to Joseph G. Smoot, President of Andrews University in 1981 by Donald F. Haynes' daughter, Dona Haynes Schultz of Pasadena, California.
