Lewis N. Holm Papers (Collection 049)

Biography

Lewis Nathan Holm (1892-1986) was a Seventh-day Adventist educator and administrator. He completed his Bachelor's degree from International Correspondence Schools c.1924, an M.S. in Botany from Michigan State College in 1936, and an Ed.D. from The Calvin Coolidge College of Liberal Arts in 1952. He married Elena Hanson on September 7, 1915.

Holm began his teacher career in the public school system. Following that experience he held the following positions in service to the Seventh-day Adventist Church:

After a career spanning forty years in denominational service, Holm enjoyed a working retirement, serving as a counseling psychologist and business consultant, teaching economic classes for the University of Southern California. He also worked as the Credit Manager, and Manager, for his son, Donald Holm's, medical center in Clearlake Highlands, California.

Holm's first wife, Elena, died May 31, 1970. He married Linea Taylor Bunch later that year on November 29, 1970. Holm died on September 5, 1986.

The Lewis N. Holm Papers includes his own autobiography, his graduate work, materials regarding his work in higher education, and writings published as MV Leaflets for youth. Also included are Holm's sermon notes and sermon illustrations.
