Barbara H. Phipps Papers (Collection 023)

Biography

Barbara H. Phipps was a Seventh-day Adventist educator and writer. She was born in 1915 to Burton and Nettie Phipps. She graduated from Emmanuel Missionary College in Berrien Springs, Michigan, in 1939, completing degrees in English and French, with a minor in German. In 1949, Barbara completed her AMLS at the University of Michigan. During the last years of her 16-year tenure as an employee at Emmanuel Missionary College, she served as the head librarian. In 1961 she joined the faculty at Pacific Union College (PUC) where she worked at the library and headed the Library Science minor program, which was later accredited by the California Department of Education. After retiring in 1981, Barbara continued to work part-time at PUC's library reference desk and received the status of associate professor of Library Science Emeritus. She died November 13, 2003, in St. Helena, California.

Scope

The Barbara H. Phipps Collection contains Barbara H. Phipps' correspondence from 1947 to 1981, as well as other documents regarding her life and work. A significant portion of this collection is related to Phipps' book entitled, *Test Tubes and Chalkdust*, including two edited manuscripts, one being an unabridged version. A written oral speech entitled, "Echoes from the College Bell," and a commemorative biography of Phipps' father, Burton H. Phipps, is also included in the collection. There are also a series of photographs of the Phipps family and friends.

The material is kept in chronological and topical sequence, in much the same order as received.
