Denton Edward Rebok Collection (Collection 075)

Biography

Denton Edward (D. E.) Rebok (1897-1983) “was to Seventh-day Adventist education in China what Dr. Harry W. Miller was to Adventist medicine over there.” This perceptive observation by an unnamed denominational administrator only tells half the story. After spending 23 years in China as a college president and conference administrator, Rebok spent almost an equal amount of time in the United States as a Bible teacher, college and seminary president, and General Conference official. He is also credited with playing a small but significant role in the denomination’s changing position on the nature of Christ. He retired in 1961 but remained active writing articles and books until his death in 1983.

Scope and Content

This collection covers the highlights of Rebok's ministry, which was marked by two halves. The first half of his ministry was in China (over 20 years) and the other half in the United States. In both countries he served as a teacher/professor and administrator, but the papers in this collection strongly reflect his role as a professor and missionary. More than half of this collection is directly associated with teaching in the Theological Seminary with a missionary emphasis. This is seen through his class materials (Section V. Teaching), theological study commissions (various items in Section VI. Topic or Subject) and contributions through the publications of articles and books (Boxes 5 to 13). Another important aspect to highlight are the sermons, talks and speeches written by him. They take up a little more than six boxes (boxes 16 to 24). Finally, his dedication to the study of the Sabbath School Lesson is evident through the notes taken by hand in his lessons (see box 2, folders 7 and 8), clippings and journals. All these aspects show in a way how his theological understanding developed through this set of documents.

The Center for Adventist Research organized this collection as it is now. It lacked organization when received.
