# Siegfried H. Horn Collection Collection 78

#### **Scope and Content**

Siegfried Herbert Nathan Horn was born to Albin and Klara Horn in Werzen, Germany, on March 17, 1908. He was interested in flying, (his father was a famous pilot), civil engineering, and medicine, but his mother influenced him to go to the seminary in Friedensau to became a minister. After brief study at Stanborough Park in England, he began ministerial duties in Holland.

He was married to his first Jeanne (he had two different wives named Jeanne) while serving as a Seventh-day Adventist missionary in the Dutch East Indies. During World War II he was taken by the Dutch and interned in prison camps in Indonesia and India. Following the war he received his B. A. degree from Walla Walla College in 1947 and his M. A. from the Seventh-day Adventist Theological Seminary in Washington, DC, in 1948. He studied at John Hopkins University with Professor William A. Albright for a short while, then was awarded his Ph.D. in Egyptology from the University of Chicago in 1951.

Siegfried joined the faculty of the Adventist Seminary and with Lynn H. Wood published *The Chronology of Ezra* 7 in 1953. While professor of Archaeology and History of Antiquity he published many articles and books on archaeology and the Bible. Probably his greatest publishing achievement was his massive contribution by way of introductory articles and commentary on Genesis, Exodus, Ezra, and Nehemiah in the seven volumes of the *Seventh-day Adventist Bible Commentary* and the *Bible Dictionary*.

In the early 1960s he began to participate in the excavation of the Tell Balatah, ancient Shechem. He conducted his own "dig" at Tell Hesban, Jordan, in 1968, 1971, 1973. He turned the directorship over to his former student, Lawrence Geraty, for 1974 and 1976 while still serving as senior advisor and project registrar.

In 1970 he founded the archaeological museum at Andrews University . After serving in various capacities at Andrews University for many years, including Dean of the Theological Seminary there, he retired to California in 1976. He continued to teach in overseas extension schools and give lectures and tours until 1992. His lifetime bibliography includes nearly 800 articles and several books in German, Dutch, and English. He donated his vast archaeological library to the Horn Archaeological Museum Library at Andrews University.

Two years following the death (1987) of his second wife also named Jeanne he made a miraculous recovery after a serious fall and surgery. Later he married Betty (Elizabeth) Leppers in October 1991. He was able to lecture at the 25<sup>th</sup> anniversary celebration of the Hesban dig combined with his 85<sup>th</sup> birthday celebration in March, 1993. He passed away on November 28, 1993, in Deer Park, California.

Horn was a meticulous recorder and collector of minute pieces of data. A review of his photograph albums and records show this exceedingly careful recording of what many of us would consider unimportant. He was very concerned with keeping and preserving a proper record of events of his life as well as other activities he was involved with. Some might consider him obsessive-compulsive, but for historians studying his life it was no doubt a useful trait to possess.

This collection contains a good number of letters from 1929 to 1976, and 1993, and diaries from his early life to 1992. There are important documents such as birth certificate, degree reports, transcriptions, etc, and information on his three wives, some personal artifacts, a collection of photographs albums, his travel reports, and awards and appreciations. Another group is his personal collection of maps. In the last part of the collection, there are some writings of Siegfried Horn, materials for the book *Survivor: A Biography of Siegfried Horn*, and others.

#### **Arrangement**

The collection was fairly well arranged in general categories, however it was not possible to tell the relationship of the categories to each other. This part of the collection organization is artificial. The arrangement of the series is as follows:

Donation Personal Awards and Appreciations Maps Writings Items Removed

Within each section the folders are arranged by person and then in a somewhat chronological arrangement. The letters and diaries are strictly chronological. The writings are strictly chronological, as well. If there is no date in one section, the arrangement is strictly alphabetical.

The items removed are either discarded or made a part of the Centers other collections.

#### **Provenance**

The collection was given in two major groups. The first one was by Siegfried H. Horn in May, 1976, and the second one by Elizabeth Horn some time after his death. There are also materials that may have come from Joyce Rochat which she used in her biography of Horn.

We do not know what happened to Horn's original diaries. The cassette tapes listed below contain a reading of his diaries. The transcripts shown are a transcript of these cassette tape recordings. We do not know for sure who transcribed the records but it may have been Joyce Rochat for her biography of Horn. The transcripts end, with some exceptions, with 1953 and then there are photocopies of the diaries through 1992. The early transcripts are likely more of Horn's recounting the history of his ancestors.


