Biography

Carl Gustav Tuland, pastor and church administrator, was born on February 6, 1901, in Berlin, Germany. His birth name was K. H. F. Tulaszewski. He began his ministry at age 20 in his home town of Berlin. Here is a summary of his work and locations.

In addition to pastoral ministry and church administration, Tuland earned a M.A. degree in Systematic Theology from the Seventh-day Adventist Theological Seminary in 1951, and a Ph.D. in Semitic Languages, Old Testament and Archaeology at the Oriental Institute of the University of Chicago in 1956.

Many of his biblical studies and religious articles were printed in various languages throughout Europe, South America and the United States. He was a member of several learned societies including The American Oriental Society, the Society of Biblical Literature and Exegesis, and was a Fellow of the Royal Asiatic Society of Great Britain and Ireland. In 1965 he was elected President of the Mid-West Section of the Society of Biblical Literature.

Scope

This collection consists mainly of Tuland's research papers and records of his ministry, including his autobiography and letters. His research papers show a wide range of interest including biblical studies, Seventh-day Adventist Church doctrines, and pastoral studies. Of particular interest is his research and files on the Seventh-day Adventist Reform Movement in Europe and Brazil.

The materials are rearranged by topical sequence. Within each topic, they are arranged chronologically or alphabetically.
