Biographical Information

Leona Rachel Glidden Running was born in 1916 near Flint, Michigan, the elder of two daughters, to Charles C. and Leona B. Glidden. Her education began in the Bay City, Michigan, Elementary Church School. She continued with her secondary education at Adelpian Academy, Holly, Michigan, graduating from there in 1933. Shortly thereafter she undertook a French major and minors in German, English, and Education from Emmanuel Missionary College, Berrien Springs, Michigan, graduating in 1937. Because of her teaching German and French she undertook further class work at the University of Michigan during the summer session, 1938.

Immediately after completing her studies from Emmanuel Missionary College, Leona Glidden began teaching French and German at Laurelwood Academy, Gaston, Oregon for a total of four years (1937-41), and in 1942 she was married to Lief H. Running, with whom she spent four meaningful years until his untimely death in 1946, in Glendale, California. She was then secretary to C. L. Bauer, Secretary-Treasurer of the Pacific Union Conference, from 1942-44.

Now holding experience in both foreign languages and secretarial skills, Leona Glidden Running worked in the Foreign Language Division of the Voice of Prophecy between the years 1944 and 1948. She typed scripts in both Spanish and Portuguese for the Central and South American Voice of Prophecy broadcast production by Elders Perez and Rabello, and also a few scripts in French and Italian. She cared for the German Bible School lessons in both the United States and Canada during World War II, and organized the German Bible School work in Europe after the war when mail service opened, and until Bible schools were set up in European countries to care for the lessons there. In the years 1948-49, she was a foreign language secretary at the Pacific Press Publishing branch at Brookfield, Illinois, and from 1949 to 1950, secretary to the President of the Carolina Conference in Charlotte, N. C. Between 1950 and 1954 she was a secretary in the General Conference Ministerial Association and copy editor for the *Ministry* magazine.

Running's love for languages, and especially Biblical languages, resulted in her decision to undertake an M.A. in Biblical Languages at the Seventh-day Adventist Theological Seminary, Takoma Park, Maryland. There she majored in Biblical Greek and took a minor in Biblical Hebrew, graduating in 1955. Immediately after completing her M.A. degree she began teaching at the Seminary, first as an Instructor, then Assistant Professor, Associate Professor, and eventually Professor of Biblical Languages. She was at the S.D.A. Theological Seminary in Takoma Park from 1955 to 1960 and stayed with the Seminary when it moved to Andrews University in Berrien Springs, Michigan. She continued full-time teaching from 1960 to 1981. She continued teaching in her retirement.

Along with her teaching at the S.D.A. Theological Seminary in Takoma Park, Leona Running began a Ph.D. program in Semitic Languages at the Johns Hopkins University, Baltimore, Maryland, specializing in Hebrew, Akkadian, and Syriac. She received her degree in 1964. Dr. Leona Glidden Running was granted Professor Emeritus of Biblical Languages status at Andrews University.

Among her many interests, Dr. Running has traveled extensively. In 1951, she traveled with Del Delker to the Paris Youth Congress and to seven European countries. Later she publishing *36 Days and a Dream* recounting her trip. The book was on the 1953 Senior Reading Course list of books. In 1957, she joined Siegfried Horn's first Guided Study Tour to Europe and the Middle East. She wrote another travelogue of this trip published in 1958 as *From Thames to Tigris*. In 1965 she traveled through Europe and studied six weeks in Israel, ending with a trip through Western Turkey and a cruise of the Aegean Isles. In 1970, she again traveled through Europe to spend eight days in Iran, a weekend on Cyprus, and ten days in Israel. In 1974, she taught in a summer session at Newbold College, England, then spent three weeks in both France and Germany with her friends of many years.

Among her publications the most notable is *William Foxwell Albright: A Twentieth-Century Genius* (Morgan Press/Two Continents, 1975), a 436 page biography of the "Dean of Biblical Archaeologists." She continued to publish in various professional journals, as well as Adventist Church publications.

Scope

Leona Glidden Running's Collection on "Women in Church and Society" spans more than a several decades in opinion and thought regarding women in the church and in society. The collection contains information in the form of files on current issues of women in church and society specifically books, articles, magazines, and audio-visuals from 1971 on. It contains information on such items as the ordination of women ministers in various denominations, women in athletic and other careers, the influence of economic conditions on women, women and marriage today, child rearing, and many, many other topics. As of 2006, Dr. Running was still adding material to the collection.

Arrangement

Dr. Running established the organization of the collection and the Center has maintained this order. The folders are referred to as "fld". They are numbered on the basis of topical sequence. Since the collection continues to expand the final arrangement is not complete. The collection is not a finished product, and the register lacks our usual level of detail.

Provenance

Dr. Running began collecting materials in 1971 and ten years later began donating it to the Center for Adventist Research at the James White Library, Andrews University. Donations continued to be made as of 2006.

Use
