Edwin H. Zackrison Papers (Collection 393)

Biography

Edwin Harry Zackrison (1941–2022) was a Seventh-day Adventist pastor, professor, and author, whose life and work were marked by his commitment to faith and education. Despite encountering controversy, particularly in some Adventist institutions, Zackrison was nonetheless recognized for his contributions in both pastoral ministry and academic settings. His influence was appreciated within the Seventh-day Adventist community and beyond, shaping thought and practice through his preaching and teaching.

Born in Hinsdale, Illinois, on October 15, 1941, Zackrison emerged from a richly diverse familial environment that included professionals in printing, education, music, art, literature, and editing. This multi disciplinary background cultivated in him a wide-ranging curiosity and capacity for integrative thinking that would later characterize his work across multiple domains. In 1966, following the completion of a Master of Arts in Theology and Christian Philosophy at Andrews University, he began his pastoral ministry as a ministerial intern at the Alhambra SDA Church in California. Demonstrating leadership and pastoral sensitivity, he went on to become the founding pastor of what is now the Camarillo SDA Church. His contributions to the congregation were recognized in 1969, when he was ordained to the gospel ministry

In his ministerial years, he held these pastoral positions:

- 1966–1967 Ministerial Intern, Alhambra SDA Church, in Alhambra, CA
- 1967–1972 Pastor, Camarillo SDA Church, in Camarillo, CA

Endowed with the gift of teaching, Zackrison transitioned to academia in 1972, accepting a faculty appointment as Assistant Professor of Religion at Southern Missionary College (now Southern Adventist University) in Tennessee. Zackrison pursued further studies throughout his career. In 1984, he completed a Ph.D. in Theological Studies at Andrews University and obtained a certification in Marriage and Family Therapy from the University of Southern California. His scholarly interests were notably interdisciplinary: he later earned a certificate in Theatre Arts from the University of Nevada in 1995 and, in 2001, a Master of Business Administration from DeVry University's Keller Graduate School of Management.

In his years as academic professional, he held these positions:

- 1984–1988 Chairman, Religion Department at La Sierra Academy, Riverside, CA
- 1985–1988 Adjunct Professor of Theology at La Sierra University, Riverside, CA
- 1988–1994 Chairman, Drama Department at La Sierra Academy, Riverside, CA
- 1988–1993 Associate Professor of Theology and Ministry at La Sierra University, Riverside, CA
- 1993–1995 Professor of Theology and Ministry at La Sierra University, Riverside, CA
- 1996–2001? Professor of Social Sciences at Mt. Sierra College, Monrovia, CA
- 2001–2014? Professor of Social Sciences and Business Administration at Miller-Motte College, Wilmington, NC

His career intersected with several significant figures and developments within the denomination. Notably, according to Robert W. Olson, Zackrison served as a ministerial intern under Walter T. Rea, with whom he maintained a personal friendship. Later in his career, he was controversially associated with Rea's book *The White Lie*, though he later clarified that he "had no part in its production, writing, editing, or endorsement," and in fact had sought to dissuade Rea from publishing it.

As a person shaped by the religious and theological currents of his time, Zackrison was closely acquainted with several major controversies within Adventism, including the cases of Donald J. Davenport, Walter T. Rea, Desmond Ford, and the *Atlanta Affirmation*, among others. Zackrison was invited to participate in the *Life of Christ Research Project*, a significant initiative in Adventist biblical scholarship led by Fred Veltman; however, he declined the invitation. Likewise, he turned down an early-career offer to join the faculty of the Bible Department at River Plate College in Argentina in 1965. His personal and professional network included the theologian Edward E. Heppenstall and fellow teacher and college president Frank A. Knittel, as demonstrated by their preserved correspondence.

Following retirement in 2014, Zackrison resided in Ringgold, Georgia, continuing to write and contribute to Adventist scholarship. Throughout his career he authored several books and numerous published and unpublished articles that explored theology, ministry, and interdisciplinary themes. His final years were marked by significant health challenges. He passed away on November 3, 2022.

Scope

The Edwin H. Zackrison Papers Collection comprises a substantial body of personal correspondence—over 1,800 letters—as well as a broad array of papers and scholarly works addressing critical themes in the history and theology of the Seventh-day Adventist Church.

Among the materials preserved are Zackrison's early academic writings, most notably those related to his doctoral dissertation on the doctrine of original sin and its implications for both human nature and Christian theology. The collection also contains a wide range of scholarly output produced throughout his career, including both published and unpublished manuscripts and monographs.

The collection is particularly rich in theological material, covering major doctrinal themes such as the nature of Christ, justification by faith, and the role of Ellen G. White in the development of Seventh-day Adventist theology. It also documents key theological and historical issues within the denomination, including perfectionism, the investigative judgment, the sanctuary doctrine, and prophecy. The thought and influence of several Adventist figures are represented, including Milian L. Andreasen, Edward E. Heppenstall, Walter T. Rea, Fred Veltman, Desmond Ford, and Frank A. Knittel, among others.

Furthermore, the collection includes materials related to pivotal events and controversies in Adventist history, particularly those from the late 1970s and 1980s. These include documentation concerning the financial scandal involving Donald J. Davenport; theological debates associated with Robert D. Brinsmead; the controversy surrounding Walter T. Rea's critique of Ellen G. White's writings; Fred Veltman's Life of Christ research project; and the theological crisis surrounding Desmond Ford, including the events leading to and following the Atlanta Affirmation in 1980.

Finally, the collection offers valuable insights into Zackrison's personal and professional life, including his interactions with various Adventist institutions and the personal challenges he faced, particularly in relation to his career and marital life.

Arrangement

The material has been organized thematically to provide a logical and coherent progression of topics. As the collection was not initially prepared with formal transfer in mind, it was received by the Center for Adventist Research in a disordered condition. While the material has since been arranged according to thematic categories for clarity and usability, the original contents of the folders and binders remain unaltered.

The following principles guided the organization of the collection:

- Items originally grouped together in folders, as well as materials found in binders—which were divided into folders for accessibility reasons only—have been preserved in their original condition as donated.
- The thematic categories applied during processing were established based on the recurrence and relevance of specific topics throughout the collection.
- In cases where materials could reasonably fall under multiple categories, they were placed under the most pertinent topic to facilitate ease of reference and retrieval.
- When a document could not be dated, "N.D." (No Date) has been applied.

Similarly, when the author could not be identified, "N.A." (No Author) has been used.

- The section titled "Correspondence and Personal Communications" was compiled by systematically extracting, where feasible, the majority of letters and personal communications of Zackrison and others from various parts of the collection. These items have been arranged chronologically to facilitate researcher access. However, in cases where relocation would have compromised the contextual integrity of a larger document arranged by Zackrison himself, the material has been retained in its original location to preserve the document's original composition and intent.

- Due to the nature of the materials held in the "Sensitive Documents" section, access is restricted. Inquiries can be directed to CAR's Director or Associate Director.

- All materials listed in the "Periodicals, Serials, and Related Material" section have been removed from this collection and integrated into CAR's periodical collection to improve accessibility and retrieval.

Following the death of Edwin H. Zackrison in 2022, his brother, James Zackrison, donated the collection to Michael W. Campbell, Ph.D, who subsequently transferred the collection to the Center in December 2023.
